Required qualifications

The term post-doc refers to an employee who is primarily employed for research and who holds a Ph.D. degree, or holds a degree from a foreign university equal to a Ph.D. degree. The degree should have been obtained no more than three years prior to the deadline. In case of special circumstances an older degree may be accepted. Such circumstances may be sickness, parental leave, medical work, commission of trust within trade unions, or similar circumstances.

In her or his research the applicant must have shown an interest relevant for teaching and learning in the social sciences.

Terms of employment

Each position is a two-year full-time appointment and involves 80 percent research and 20 percent teaching. The expected starting date is January 1, 2014 or as agreed.

Applications should comprise the following:

- Letter that explains the applicant's interest in and competence for the position;
- Research plan;
- Detailed CV, including list of publications;
- Certified copies of degree and employment certificates;
