The course will provide knowledge (theoretical and practical) on the generation and analysis of plant microbiome data. Lectures will describe the pivotal role of plant-associated bacteria on plant health and productivity and the “state of the art” in this field, together with the description of different approaches to move from the laboratory data to practical applications in agriculture. Topics will include:

- Plant microbiome
- Plant beneficial bacteria
- Bioinoculants
- Plant-bacteria signaling

Participants

- Scientists currently involved in R&D activities or studies related to plant microbiome and/or related applications
- Participation is subject to selection. A limited number of participants (20) are admitted to both the Practical and Theoretical components of the Course. Other participants will be selected to attend only the Theoretical Sessions held in the mornings
- Selection will be based on applicants' CV and potential benefit for their research; priority will be given to PhD or postdoctoral students. Geographical and gender balance will also be considered
- Selected participants will need to finalize their registration with payment of the relevant registration fee:
 - *Complete Course: Euro 200
 - *Theoretical Sessions: Euro 100

Funding

- A limited number of grants will be available for nationals of **ICGEB Member States** to waive the complete Course registration fee, cover twin-share accommodation and local hospitality for the duration of the Course
- Interested, eligible applicants must REGISTER online and additionally upload a MOTIVATION STATEMENT
- Requests for financial support without the necessary motivation statement will not be considered
- The selection will be based on the following criteria:
 - *Scientific relevance of the practical course to participant's own work
 - *Work performed in developing countries
 - *Date of application
