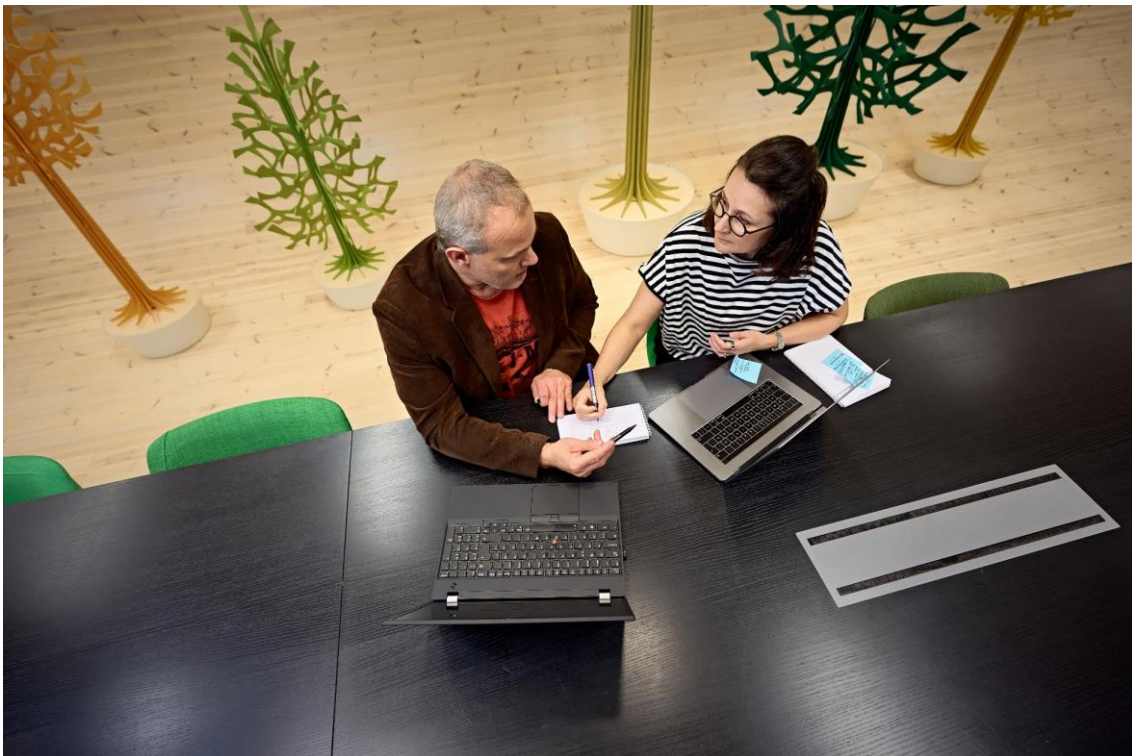
Event	Description (Location: Foodoo Garden/Timjami)

1.2. How to Utilize a Digimmentor

The digimmentors of the faculties are experts in pedagogy, helping teachers with low-threshold support, working together with you. How to design a remote course where students genuinely interact with the teacher and other students? How to organize a large course so that the teaching is of high quality and does not cause an enormous workload for the teacher? Digimmentors can help for example with the following issues:

- Guidance on practical arrangements for hybrid teaching, from planning to implementation
- Designing face-to-face/hybrid/remote courses in a digitally pedagogically high-quality way
- Choosing, building, and guiding the use of a meaningful platform/digital tool for learning, e.g. Moodle, Howspace, ThingLink
- Video learning materials and utilizing learning analytics from videos
- Guidance on AI, accessibility, video recording possibilities for teaching, the Opin.fi service, UNIC
- Developing a MOOC course
