Menu structure



All units share the same basic menu structure

The amount of required pages is kept to a minimum

Additional content is allowed

- All units are able to maintain an up to date web presence, in the agreed format
- Those units with more activity can maintain a more extensive website



Menu structure

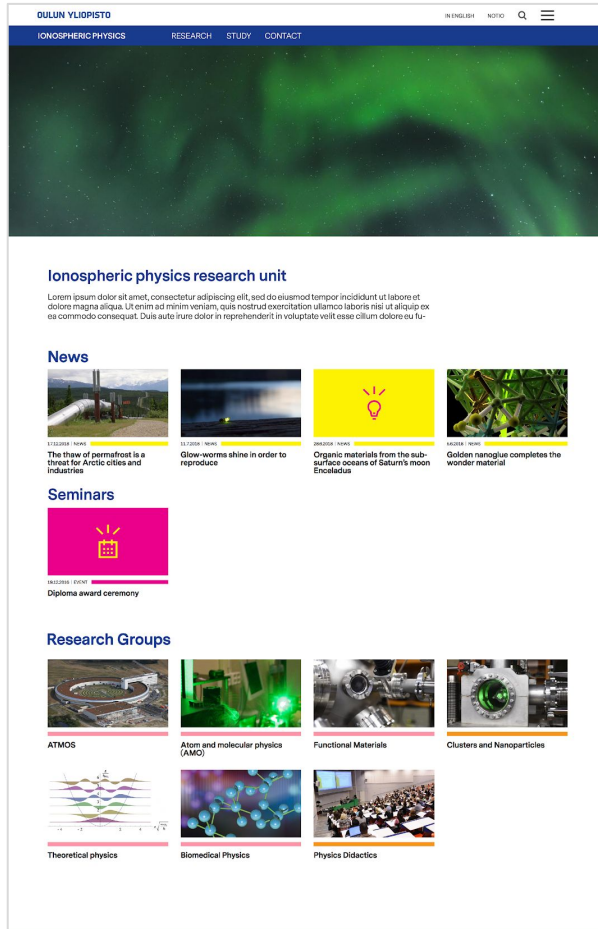


Minimum required content:

- Research (Tutkimus)
- Study (Opiskelu)
- Contact (Yhteystiedot)

Extra content:

- Publications (Julkaisut)
- Infrastructure (Infrastruktuurit)
- Theses (Väitökset)



Research unit frontpage

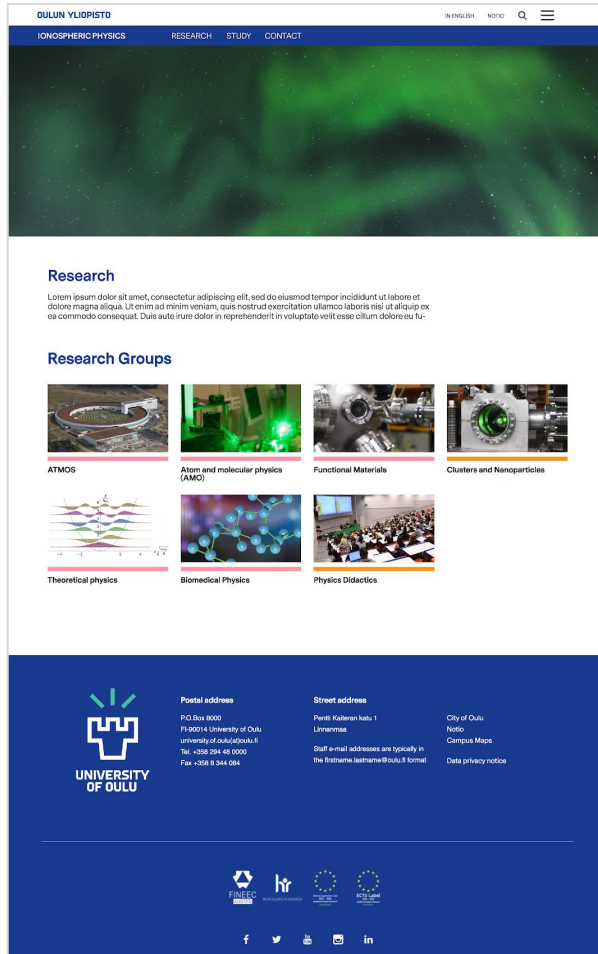
The front page is similar in structure to the faculty front page.

Minimum required content:

- A description of the research unit
- List of research groups (liftups)

Extra content:

- liftup row for news
- liftup row for seminars



Research page

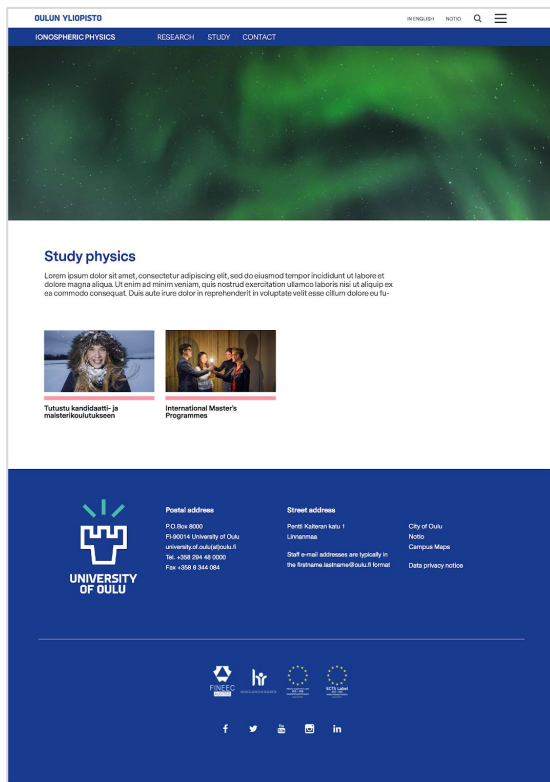
The research page presents the research activities in detail.

Minimum required content:

- Short description of research goals
- List of research groups

Extra content:

- Extended description of research goals and activities
- Liftup row for research-related news



Study page

The study page should contain a short introduction of the field and link to the University Admissions page.

Contains basic contact information.

Can contain a list of all research unit members.

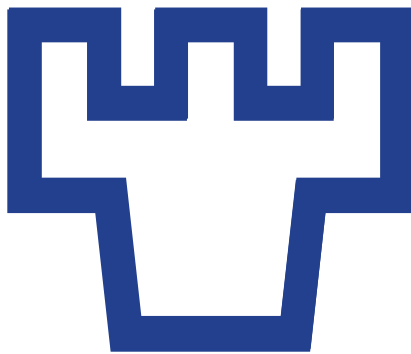
