iversity is an interdisciplinary workspace, especially designed for the requirements of academics.

The platform supports and simplifies both individual and collaborative working.

How to work with *iversity*?

1. Register at www.iversity.org
2. Create a *profile* with your personal information
3. Create or join a *research project, event* or *course*
4. Add *topics* or *dates* in each group
5. Add different kinds of *contributions* (links, reader entries, files, discussions) to each topic or date
