

The Finnish Cancer Institute – Applications for K. Albin Johansson Research Professor and K. Albin Johansson Cancer Researcher by 16 November 2012

The research fields should cover mainly epidemiological, clinical, or experimental cancer research carried out in Finland.

K. ALBIN JOHANSSON RESEARCH PROFESSOR

A 5-year professorship (EUR 5,300 a month), commencing on 1 April 2013 at the earliest.

I) In the first stage, please submit

- a letter of intent (maximum 2 pages)
- your curriculum vitae (maximum 1 page)
- a list of publications; 20 of the most relevant publications from the viewpoint of the post in question; after each publication give its impact factor.

The application, including all enclosures, is to be sent by e-mail to the Secretary-General, and must reach the office by 3 pm on Friday 16 November 2012.

The first page of the letter of intent contains the applicant's contact information, the research topic and the institute where the research will be carried out. The application and enclosures must be on one PDF file (font size 12). The name of the file is the applicant's surname. The application can be written in Finnish, Swedish or English.

II) In the second stage, the Scientific Advisory Committee of the Finnish Cancer Institute selects those candidates who will be asked to submit a comprehensive research plan in English by 17 December 2012 to be sent to specialists abroad.

K. ALBIN JOHANSSON CANCER RESEARCHER

The 2-year post is meant for a post-doctoral cancer researcher (of becoming an independent researcher; EUR 3,150 a month).

Application: A free-form research plan, maximum 5 pages (font size 12). The first page must contain the applicant's contact information, the research topic and the institute where the research will be carried out. Enclosures: a brief CV (1 page) and a list of publications (after each publication give its impact factor). The application can be written in Finnish, Swedish or English.

Sending the applications and deadline: The applications, including enclosures, are sent by e-mail, and must reach the Secretary-General's office by 3 pm on Friday 16 November 2012. The application and enclosures are sent as one PDF file (font size 12), and the file is to be named according to the applicant's surname. The application will be handled in the form in which it is when submitted at the deadline.

Decisions: The names of the recipients of the posts will be published in March 2013. Work in the posts commences by 1 April 2013 at the earliest. The recipients of the posts will be informed by e-mail and their names will be published on the website www.cancer.fi
