


### **The Biochemistry of Cellular Systems**

**We are seeking an outstanding research student for the final place on our Wellcome Trust-funded PhD Programme, for entry in January 2008.**

We focus on the function and regulation of protein complexes in health and disease, in:

- Gene expression
- Organelle biogenesis and membrane trafficking
- Extracellular matrix, cell adhesion and the cytoskeleton
- Cell division and apoptosis



We offer an excellent intellectual and scientific environment, a choice of 36 well-funded research laboratories, and a generous stipend (currently ~£16k-£18k).

The first eight months of the programme involves two laboratory-based projects. The projects are supported by a taught module. Based on the experience you gain during this time, you will choose the topic and supervisor for your PhD research which will last for a further 3 years.
